Subject: top 5 reasons to close Indian Point

1. More than 1500 tons of radioactive waste are stored in unfortified containers on the banks of the Hudson River.
2. More than 1 billion fish and other organisms are killed by Indian Point's cooling water intakes every year.
3. Indian Point's evacuation plan is rated "unworkable".
4. More than 20 million Americans in and around NYC and the Hudson Valley are at risk in the case of a meltdown.
5. We don't need Indian Point's power. We already have a surplus through 2020. And we can invest in renewable energy, efficiency, and transmission at a cost as little as \$1-\$5 per month for the typical homeowner.
