I have lived within 5 miles from this facility since 1964. This facility is too old to continue running in our area. Problems are common which cause temporary shutdowns every year for the past 5-10 years. It is known that the storage pools leak and are full. Entergy has done nothing about permanent storage for these used rods. The facility has outlived its usefulness and like anything else is now beyond repair. It is time to just plain close it down.

Indian Point is on top of two earthquake fault lines. IT just is not worth the risk of a serious problem in the future. New York has other sources of energy to replace Indian Point. The evacuation plan is a joke. It is time to close it.
