In a letter dated May 21, 2012, Matthew Wenzel, CEO for Hedrick Medical Center (HMC), contacted the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission and indicated that you wished to terminate your byproduct materials license no. 24-32027-01, concurrent with the merger of this licensed program into the license for St. Luke's Hospital of Kansas City, license no. 24-00889-01.

The NRC staff has reviewed your letter, including the attached Form NRC 314 dated May 22, 2012, and the letter from St. Luke's Hospital of Kansas City dated June 1, 2012. Based on our review NRC license number 24-32027-01 is hereby terminated with the enclosed Amendment No. 07.
