### **RE: San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station (SONGS)**

Dear Chairwoman Macfarlane:

I write to you on behalf of concerned residents of the City of West Hollywood regarding the safety of San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station (SONGS).

The people of the City of West Hollywood are served by Southern California Edison and are, therefore, directly impacted by decisions regarding the San Onofre facility. These concerns stem from the January 2012 event at SONGS during which a reactor coolant leak occurred which forced the shutdown of the nuclear reactors.

As the Mayor of the City of West Hollywood, I have been asked to send a letter voicing safety concerns to the various regulatory agencies that have oversight and regulatory functions over SONGS.

The City of West Hollywood places public safety as its highest priority, and it is our duty to be the voice of our constituents. As such, the City is requesting that the US NRC, the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC), and SCE to continue your due diligence and independent review of this incident, to address public concerns that have been raised in an open and transparent manner, and to ensure






that the SONGS plant is only permitted to restart when the NRC has determined that it can be operated in a manner that protects the health and safety of the public and the environment.

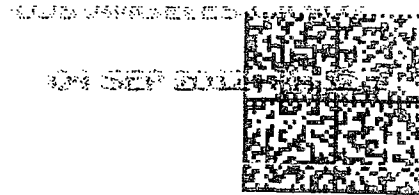
