Subject: Deny Indian Point a license extension

To whom it may concern:

I strongly oppose the extension of the NRC license for Indian Point Nuclear Powerplant in New York. This facility is within 20 miles of New York City, and the risks this facility poses are not worth the benefits. Indian Point has one of the poorest safety records of any nuclear facility in the country, and sits atop an earthquake fault line capable of producing an earthquake greater than the facility was built to withstand. The facility is out-of-date, and the power it supplies are not immediately necessary to meet regional power demands. The economic devastation that would be wrought nation-wide by a nuclear disaster so close to New York City and the global economic markets is it home to, not to mention the humanitarian costs of a Fukushima-like disaster in an area home to more than 20 million US citizens is an unacceptable risk.
