Including the shipment scheduled for tomorrow (9/20/12), the Hematite site will have shipped approximately 10,000 tons of soil and debris to USEI under the first approved alternate disposal authorization and exemptions (~20% by weight). None have shipped as Class 7 radioactive. All have qualified as unregulated DOT exempt shipments.
