### COMMENTS/RECOMMENDATIONS

*Further develop description as it only includes SOARCA and not actual session itself. What is new in this area (within 1 year), and how is this work being used by the program offices?*

Revised (in Yellow)

The U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission's (NRC's) State-of-the-Art Reactor Consequence Analyses (SOARCA) research project is designed to estimate the realistic outcomes of nuclear power plant severe accident scenarios. The project also evaluated and improved methods and models for realistically evaluating plant responses during severe accidents, including protective actions for the public (such as evacuation and sheltering), and the potential public health risk. The NRC performed this study, in part, to develop information about the effectiveness of methods for mitigating severe accidents at nuclear power plants to prevent or minimize harm to the public. The SOARCA study seeks to produce more realistic estimates of plant behavior during severe accidents, thereby improving understanding of consequences of a potential accident. Within the past year, NRC staff has met with the SOARCA Peer Review Committee multiple times and part of this session will include a perspective of the SOARCA Peer Review. Additionally, within the past year, NRC has initiated an uncertainty study for SOARCA and this session will include a discussion of this uncertainty study.
