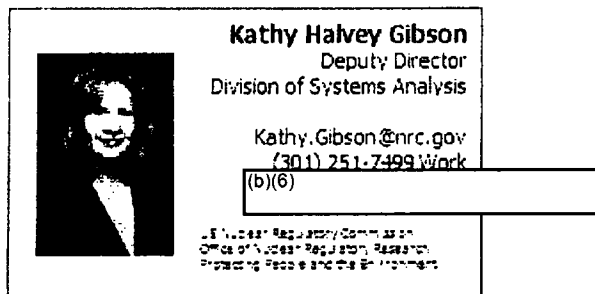

Mike would like all of the DEDMRT offices to develop graphics to track long-term projects. The purpose would be to make it easier to share how significant projects are tracking and facilitate communicating this information to the Commission and external stakeholders (OMB, Congress, Agreement States).

The format and appearance of these graphics would be up to the office. I attached an example of one prepared by NMSS to show key milestones for fuel facilities. For RES, Mike suggested starting with SOARCA, Level III PRA, and the cancer risk study. Mike indicated that he'll be looking to discuss this more at the next DEDMRT/OD monthly meeting and ask about progress.
