Please find enclosed Application For Materials License to support amendment to license number 21-32837-01. This amendment request is to change the individual responsible for radiation safety.

The before mentioned material license identifies Brenda Wisniewski as the Radiation Safety Officer. Mrs. Wisniewski is no longer employed by Gentex Corporation and Austin Russell has been appointed as the Radiation Safety Officer.

Mr. Russell's experience relevant to radioactive materials includes working for the U.S. Department of Defense at Puget Sound Naval Shipyard in Bremerton, WA from 1992 thru 1994. Mr. Russell was an Assistant Shift Test Engineer with responsibilities to conduct pre-test inspections and monitor tests of radioactive systems (unsealed sources of uranium 235) within nuclear reactor compartments aboard aircraft carriers, cruisers and submarines. Work within radiological controlled areas required TLD monitoring and entry into reactor compartments required pocket dosimetry. Additionally, Mr. Russell was responsible for conducting audits and compliance reviews of radioactive systems.

While working for the Department of Defense, Mr. Russell received training in radiation safety, basic reactor theory and power plant operations. Mr. Russell holds an AAS degree in Marine Engineering Technology from the Great Lakes Maritime Academy in Traverse City, Michigan and a BS degree in Electrical Engineering Technology from Lake Superior State University in Sault Sainte Marie, Michigan. Additionally, Mr. Russell will be attending Introduction to Radiation Safety training at Oak Ridge Associated Universities November 5-9, 2012.

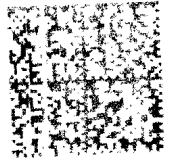
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
