identified his interest in discussing the shipments of Ir-192 identified in Tables 4 and 5 of their letter to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission dated August 10, 2012 (ML12242A286). In these tables, MURR identified approximately eight shipments per month of Ir-192 to customers near Boston and New Orleans as well as in southern California. Chris Allen asked how many customers were supplied Ir-192 in each of these locations. Michael Flagg indicated that MURR had one customer in each of these locations. He also identified that the customers in the Boston area and southern California utilized Ir-192 for developing cancer therapies and the customer in the New Orleans area utilized Ir-192 for industrial radiography. When queried about the frequency of shipments to each customer, Michael Flagg responded that approximately 2-4 shipments per month were made to the customer in the Boston area and 4-6 shipments were made to the customer in southern California with the possibility of increased shipments to the customer in southern California. Michael Flagg also indicated that shipments to the customer in the New Orleans area was very intermittent and that no shipments had occurred within the previous two years. The call was concluded at approximately 12:10 P.M.
