In a letter dated 8/8/12, CT Radiology requested that Ricardo Sein-Najera, D.O. be listed as an AU for 35.100; 35.200; and 35.300. By e-mail dated 9/13/12, I requested that the licensee provide NRC 313A(AUD) and (AUT) forms for Dr. Sein. On 9/1/12, the 313 forms were provided. After reviewing the documents I determined that they did not provide verification that the preceptor was an authorized user. The preceptor form states that Daniel Lee, M.D. (Emory University School of Medicine) is an AU for 35.100, 35.200, and 35.300 materials. I contacted the Georgia Department of Health and spoke to Joel Mimms. According to Mr. Mimms, Dr. Lee is an AU on the Emory license, however, the Emory license is a broad scope license and does not specifically list Dr. Lee as an AU. Mr. Mimms gave me the contact information for the Emory RSO (Ike Hall). I contacted Mr. Hall and he confirmed that Dr. Lee is an AU for 35.100, 35.200, and 35.300 materials. He stated that he would provide a copy of the broad scope authorization for Dr. Lee.
