*Courtesy Notice:* Cameco confirmed Well DM-010 was on excursion on June 6, 2011. Well DM-010 was then scheduled to be sampled every seven days for Chloride, Alkalinity, Conductivity, and Uranium until the excursion is mitigated. Upon approval from LQD, Cameco installed excursion control wells in the Mine Unit D area in May, 2012. The excursion control wells became operational mid-September. Well DM-010 has been below excursion limits for the UCLs for three (3) consecutive weeks. As of October 3, 2012, this excursion is considered mitigated and no longer on an excursion status. Well DM-010 will resume its normal 60-day sampling frequency. Data and information on Well DM-010 will be provided in the October Excursion Update.
