Subject: Acceptance of Terms Re: July 17, 2012 Letter Granting Permission to GE Hitachi Nuclear Energy to Use the RBHT Test Facility Data

This letter communicates the acceptance of the terms presented by the NRC in the Reference 1 letter dated July 17, 2012.

GE Hitachi Nuclear Energy (GEH) will not directly or indirectly disclose, allow access to, transmit, or transfer the RBHT test facility data to a third party without NRC's prior written consent.

GEH will disclose the RBHT test facility data only to those GEH employees and GEH consultants who have a need to know.

Prior to disclosing the RBHT test facility data to such GEH employees and GEH consultants, GEH will issue appropriate instructions to satisfy its obligations as described in Reference 1 and will obtain their written agreement to receive and use the RBHT test facility data on a proprietary basis on the same conditions as specified in Reference 1.
