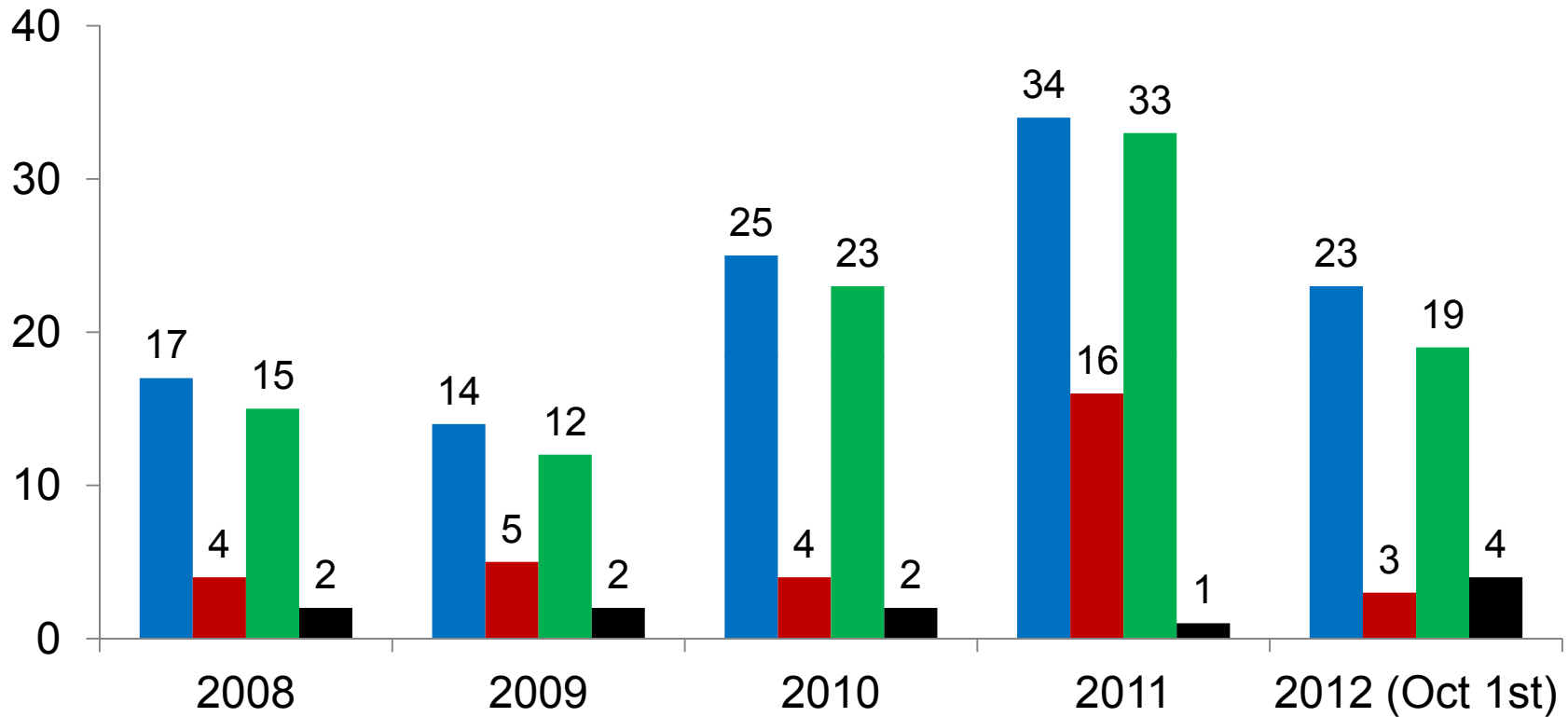

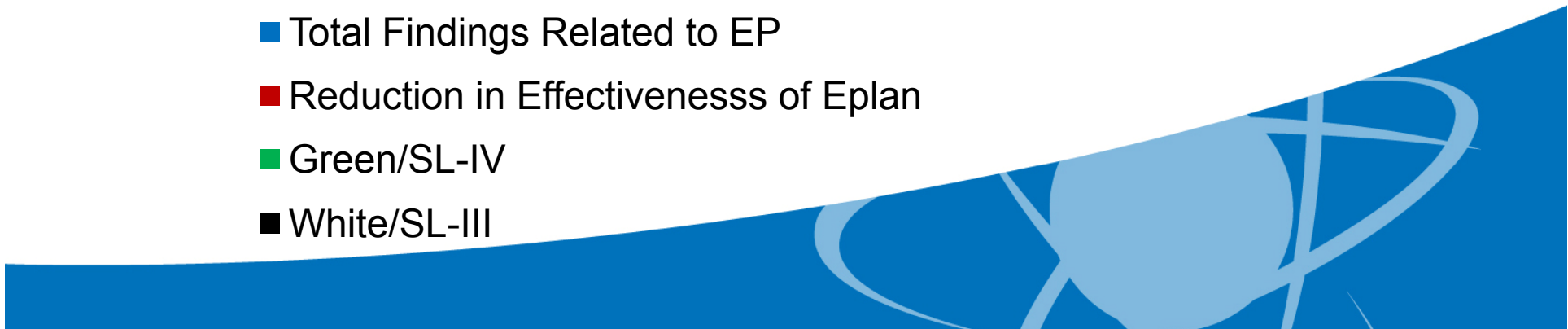

- White/SL-III

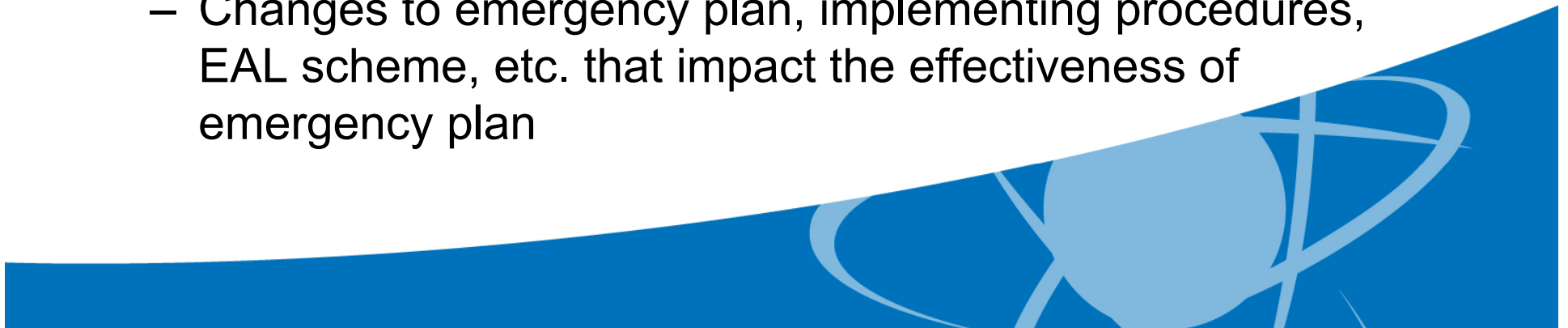


# ***Regulations***

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- 10 CFR 50.54(q)(2) – Follow and maintain effectiveness of emergency plan
  - ROP SDP
  - Changes to plant equipment, procedures, facilities, etc. that impact the effectiveness of emergency plan
- 10 CFR 50.54(q)(3) – Allowances for changes without NRC approval
  - Traditional Enforcement – deprives NRC of regulatory oversight
  - Changes to emergency plan, implementing procedures, EAL scheme, etc. that impact the effectiveness of emergency plan



# ***Regulations***

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- 10 CFR 50.47 (b)(16): “Responsibilities for plan development and review and for distribution of emergency plans are established, and planners are properly trained.”
- Site ownership of program



# ***NRC Guidance***

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- Revision to NUREG-0654/FEMA-REP-1
  - Guidance for training of emergency preparedness staff
    - Initial and continuing training
  - Guidance for training of emergency response organization (ERO) members
    - Systematic Approach to Training (SAT)
