Dear Members of the Licensing Board:

Pursuant to the Board's October 7, 2011 Order (Procedures for Evidentiary Filings), Entergy Nuclear Operations, Inc. ("Entergy") submits the following revised exhibits.

Entergy is submitting a revised version of its testimony on contention RK-TC-2 regarding flow-accelerated corrosion, ENTR00029. The revised testimony includes a corrected response to Question 131. First, the words "no more than" and "FAC-related" have been inserted into the sentence that begins "Regarding the leaks over the five-year period . . . ." That sentence now reads: "Regarding the leaks over the five-year period covered by RIV000024, there were no more than 16 instances of FAC-related leaks identified within the extensive . . . ." Second, the numbers in the following sentence have been corrected. That sentence now reads: ". . . there were 13 leaks across both plants in 2001 and 2002, but only 3 in the next three years." Entergy made no other changes to the testimony.

In accordance with the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board ("Board") Order of September 14, 2012, Entergy is also submitting the attached presentation on the CHECWORKS Program to be given at the upcoming hearing. In accordance with the e-mail of the Board's law clerk, this presentation has not been designated as an exhibit.
