10/11/2012 (13:30) I spoke to the receptionist who put me in touch with Mr. Clark. Mr. Clark stated that it was the intention of the licensee to allow the license to expire. He explained that the Charleston Area Medical Center had submitted an amendment to the hospital license to include their location of use on its license. I informed Mr. Clark that we still needed a written letter from the licensee telling the NRC of its intention not to renew its license. Mr. Clark stated that Kim Lowe, Pharm. D. had an action in for the hospital and that Tara Weidner was the reviewer. I looked up the hospital's license and determined that Ms. Weidner had a telephone discussion with Dr. Lowe about this issue and requested letters from the administrators of the three imaging centers that the hospital intended to include in its locations of use. I informed Mr. Clark of this and went over the information that would be required in the letter from his administrator in order to close out the license. Since the license expires on October 31<sup>st</sup>, attention should be focused on this matter. Mr. Clark agreed to draft the letter.
