In 1986, the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) assumed licensing authority for uranium mills in New Mexico. The Homestake Mining Company mill and United Nuclear Churchrock mill are both sites listed on the EPA's National Priorities List of hazardous waste sites. As such, the State of New Mexico has management assistance responsibilities for both these sites. The State, therefore, requests that all future documents regarding or effecting the Homestake Mining Company mill and United Nuclear Churchrock mill be forwarded to the New Mexico Environment Department, Superfund Section.
