INTERNATIONAL TO DISCUSS A REVISION REQUEST TO ADD HIGH ENRICHED URANYL NITRATE AS AUTHORIZED CONTENTS IN THE MODEL NO. NAC-LWT TRANSPORTATION PACKAGE (TAC NO.

L24678)

## **Background**

A meeting was held on September 11, 2012, in Rockville, Maryland. NAC International (NAC or the applicant) asked for the meeting to discuss a revision request to add high enriched uranyl nitrate (HEUNL) as an authorized content in the NAC-LWT Certificate of Compliance (CoC) No. 9225. This request is a high priority for review to support the Department of Energy's Global Threat Reduction Program. Additionally, NAC discussed the need for an expedited review.

The meeting was noticed on August 21, 2012 (ML12235A353). The meeting attendance list is provided as Enclosure No. 1.

## Discussion

The discussion generally followed the agenda (Enclosure No. 2). The primary reason for the meeting was to discuss a request for a revision to CoC No. 9225 to authorize the addition of HEUNL as authorized contents.

The request is to ship the HEUNL from Canada to the U.S. under the Foreign Research Reactor fuel return program. The payload is high enriched liquid target material.

NAC first provided a general overview of the revision request, followed by technical presentations and a discussion of the schedule. The basket design and the fuel description were generally described.

In the shielding evaluation discussion, NAC described the use of ORIGEN-S computer code in the depletion model to calculate the source terms. Additionally, a 3-D Monte Carlo Neutral Particles (MCNP) model was used to calculate the dose rates.

NAC intends to schedule another pre-application meeting later in the calendar year followed closely by the receipt of the application.
