This refers to your license amendment request dated October 23, 2012. Enclosed with this letter is the amended license. The amended license authorizes you to possess 4 Seaman Nuclear Corporation portable gauges. You must request an amendment to your license prior to acquiring additional gauge(s).

The amended license is written in accordance with current NRC policy. Condition 11 of the license is revised in accordance with the NRC policy, and Condition 18 that appears in your initial license is removed from the amended license because it is not applicable to the gauges that are authorized on the license.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand and fully implement all the conditions incorporated into the amended license. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region I Office, Licensing Assistance Team, (610) 337-5239, so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.

An environmental assessment for this action is not required, since this action is categorically excluded under 10 CFR 51.22(c)(14).
