# NRC STAFF'S MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME FOR THE SUBMISSION OF THE STAFF'S 45<sup>TH</sup> UPDATE TO THE HEARING FILE

Pursuant to 10 C.F.R. § 2.323(a), the NRC Staff ("Staff") hereby requests an extension of time until Tuesday, November 6, 2012, for the filing of the 45<sup>th</sup> update to the Hearing File in this proceeding. As discussed below, counsel for the Staff ("Staff Counsel") has discussed this motion with counsel for Entergy Nuclear Operations, Inc. ("Entergy" or "Applicant"), the State of New York ("New York") and Riverkeeper, Inc. ("Riverkeeper"); none of those parties oppose the Staff's motion. Staff Counsel was unable to reach counsel for Hudson River Sloop Clearwater Inc. ("Clearwater"). In support of this Motion, the Staff states as follows:

- 1. The Staff's 45<sup>th</sup> update to the Hearing File is due on October 31, 2012.
- 2. Because of Hurricane Sandy, the NRC (like other government offices in the Washington, D.C. area) was closed to non-essential personnel October 29 and 30, 2012.
- 3. In addition, several NRC Staff employees were unavailable and/or on official travel or annual leave during the period of October 25 to 26, 2012.
- 4. Given the hurricane-related government closure and NRC Staff employee unavailability, the Staff requires additional time in which to prepare and submit its 45<sup>th</sup> update to the Hearing File.
- 5. Due to the closure of the NRC on October 29-30, 2012, the Staff was not able to file this motion prior to today, the date the Hearing File update is due to be filed.

6. In accordance with 10 C.F.R. § 2.323(b), Staff Counsel has contacted counsel for New York, Riverkeeper, and Entergy, none of whom objected to this request for an extension of

time. Staff Counsel made numerous attempts to reach counsel for Clearwater, but those

attempts were unsuccessful.

7. The Staff respectfully submits that this request for an extension of time is not

unreasonable under the circumstances, and will not cause hardship for any party or substantial

delay in the proceeding.

WHEREFORE, the Staff respectfully requests that the Staff be afforded an extension of

time, until November 6, 2012, in which to file its 45th update to the Hearing File.
