You must be in full compliance with 10 CFR 73.55(e)(9)(v)(B) within 30 days of the date of this letter. Additionally, it is our understanding that you currently have implemented, consistent with the Millstone site procedures, compensatory measures for the protection of a vital area. The NRC expects that adequate compensatory measures for the protection of a vital area will remain in place during the 30 day period.
