SUBJECT: Saint Louis University NRC License Amendment Request for Line Item

Addition for Yttrium-90 Microspheres; NRC License No. 24-00196-07, Docket No. 030-11789 PLEASE EXPEDITE DUE TO PENDING

PATIENTS' MEDICAL NEEDS.

Dear Ms. Casey:

This letter is in follow-up to our telephone conversation earlier this week regarding clarification of our NRC license to remove any potential ambiguity permitting the receipt, possession and use of Therasphere® and SIR-Spheres® Yttrium-90 Microspheres by the Saint Louis University Hospital Nuclear Medicine Department.

Issue: Condition 10.A. of our license broadly permits use of licensed materials at our facilities within the listed street boundaries, which includes Saint Louis University Hospital. Condition 10.C. was later added to specifically list the address for the Saint Louis University Hospital Nuclear Medicine Department (3635 Vista Avenue, 2nd Floor South, Nuclear medicine, St. Louis Missouri) to more easily facilitate radiopharmaceutical shipments by vendors, who preferred to see the specific shipping address listed on the license. While Condition 10.A. does not limit the licensed materials that can be used at our facilities, including Saint Louis University Hospital, the more specific Condition 10.C. limits the licensed materials that can shipped directly to the Nuclear Medicine Department to those "listed in Subitems 6A. though 6.C. and 6.E.".

Amendment Request: For clarity, we are requesting a line item amendment to the license that will permit the receipt, possession and use of Therasphere® and SIR-Spheres® Yttrium-90 Microspheres at Saint Louis University Hospital, to be shipped directly to the Nuclear Medicine Department. The shipping address is 3635 Vista Avenue, 2nd Floor South, Nuclear Medicine Dept., St. Louis, Missouri (consistent with Condition 10.C. of our license). We are requesting a

Yttrium-90 microspheres possession limit of <u>5 Curies</u> to allow for multiple patient treatments each week over the long-term.

Request for Expedited Review and Approval: We are requesting expedited review of this amendment request due to medical needs of patients. Our Nuclear Medicine Authorized User anticipates beginning treatments in early to mid-November 2012. We would be very grateful if NRC expedited review and approval could be received by Friday, November 2, 2012 to permit adequate time for vendor to receive a copy of our license and make necessary arrangements for shipments.
