Dear Administrative Judges:

Pursuant to 10 C.F.R. §§ 2.1203 and 2.336 (as amended August 3, 2012 (77 Fed. Reg. 46562)) and as modified by the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board's ("Board") Initial Scheduling Order dated April 4, 2011 (as amended Orders dated August 23, 2011 and October 3, 2011), and the Board's Memorandum and Order (Granting Joint Motion Regarding Mandatory Disclosures) ("Order"), dated November 10, 2011, the staff of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission ("Staff") is providing an index (Attachment 1) identifying documents subject to disclosure under the Board's Order.
