Topic Discussion and Outcome

Discussion Topic	Discussion Outcome
Vehicle Barrier System	NINA will provide a more legible plot plan (instead of Figure 1.2-37 in Chapter 20) to show the VBS location relative to the structures. In addition, a draft FSAR description will help with this resolution.
2. RWB SSE design	The ITAAC for the radwaste tunnel is for seismic II/I consideration. There is no ITAAC for the radwaste tunnel design.
3. RWB flood design	NINA advised that the RG 1.143 R2 flood design guidance of ½ PMF has been met because PMF is 26 ft whereas the RWB is designed to 33 ft. Staff will consider the definition of PMF and will defer discussion until next meeting.
November 1, 2012 ACRS Full Committee Meeting	Staff has no comments on the NINA draft slides except a clarification on the use of the auxiliary feedwater injection system as an alternate source of water to the core.
5. UHS Basin Evaluation	The description of the UHS basin beams and columns evaluation is in the response to RAI 03.07.01-29 S1 R1, sheet 14. Staff will review this information.
6. Overturning Evaluation	S&L will perform an evaluation and NINA will advise schedule.
7. Fukushima Recommendation 2.1	Staff advised that the status of the audit report has not changed. Staff also informed NINA that the GMPE used in the EPRI model and CEUS SSC model are not the same as the STP model. NINA will take the appropriate action and will advise in the next meeting.
