In awarding the contract to the Doubletree Hotel for the IRRS lessons learned, DC staff had to determine the prices were fair and reasonable. DC has augmented its July 2011 determination to include an analysis of refreshment costs in light of the OMB memorandum, and it contained below.

SUBJECT:	Summary of Purchase Order NRC-HQ-11-P-03-0163 for the Integrated Regulatory Review Services (IRRS) Lessons Learned Workshop

### **Background**

On July 6, 2011, the Division of Contracts received a RFPA to provide conference/meeting facilities and audiovisual equipment for the Integrated Regulatory Review Services (IRRS) Lessons Learned Workshop on October 26-28, 2011. Consistent with agency practice, the RFP did not include a requirement for food. The IGCE was \$45,951.00.

On July 15, 2011, the requirement was posted on the Federal Business Opportunities website and invited interested concerns to contact the contract specialist (CS) Nancy Lamon-Kritikos for the RFQ. In addition, the RFQ was sent to three hotels recommended by the project officer (PO), Chutima Taylor:

- 1. DoubleTree by Hilton Hotel Bethesda at 8120 Wisconsin Avenue, Bethesda, MD 20814
- 2. Bethesda North Marriott Hotel and Conference Center at 5701 Marinelli Road, Rockville, MD 20852
- 3. Hyatt Regency-Bethesda at 7400 Wisconsin Avenue, Bethesda, MD 20814

Several venues reported low availability in the month of October because it is peak season for special events. The following concerns indicated that they did not have space available on the required dates:

- 1. Hyatt Regency-Bethesda
- 2. Bethesda North Marriott Hotel and Conference Center
- 3. Bethesda Marriott at 5151 Pooks Hill Road, Bethesda, MD 20814

The closing date and time specified in the RFQ was 5:00 pm EST July 21, 2011. Two quotations were timely received from the following concerns:

- 1. DoubleTree by Hilton Hotel Bethesda for \$44,453.60
- 2. Hilton Washington DC North/Gaithersburg for \$6,801.50

The CS evaluated the quotes for compliance with the requirements in the RFQ. Although the quote from the Hilton Washington DC North/Gaithersburg was timely received, it does not meet the minimum technical requirements stated in the RFQ and affirmed by the PO. According to Google Maps (Attachment #1), the Hilton Washington DC North/Gaithersburg is 3.8 miles from the nearest Metro Station (Shady Grove Metro Station). Due to the large number of international attendees, the NRC required the following:

- 1. The venue must be within a ten (10)-minute walk of a Metro Station.
- 2. The Metro Station closest to the venue must be no more than a ten (10)-minute Metro ride from the NRC Headquarters facility located adjacent to the White Flint Metro Station at 11555 Rockville Pike, Rockville, MD 20852.

The DoubleTree's quote for \$44,453.60 was timely received and determined to be a technically acceptable quotation at a reasonable price. The quotation included pricing for 1) a Day Meeting Package, 2) one breakout room, and 3) additional audiovisual equipment that was not included in the package. The quotation indicated the refreshments would be provided as part of the package, and that the pricing for food was non-severable. See attached spreadsheet for types of items that could be provided at the concern's continuous break station. The DoubleTree is registered in CCR under the business name of Tar Heel Lessee, LLC, DBA Doubletree Bethesda Hotel and is not on the Excluded Parties List as of July 26, 2011.

## Day Meeting Package Price Reasonableness Determination

The Doubletree Day Meeting Package for room rental, audiovisual equipment, and refreshments for the IRRS workshop on October 26-27, 2011 from 8:00 am – 6:00 pm and October 28, 2011 from 8:00 am – 1:00 pm to accommodate approximately 200 individuals was quoted at a price of approximately \$84 per person for a full day and \$42 per person for a half day, inclusive of the service charge, for a total price of \$42,000.00. This represents a 23% discount from the Doubletree's standard rate of \$109 per full day.

On July 27, 2011, the CS requested a revised price proposal from the Doubletree. The Doubletree responded that they had provided their best offer in the original quotation. They stated that their prices have increased to \$119 per person since the quote was submitted, and they had already provided a significant discount from their previous rate of \$109 per person.

In response to the CS's request to break out the package pricing and obtain costs for just the room rental and audiovisual equipment, the Doubletree stated they do not provide non-severable package pricing for their Executive Meeting Center (EMC), which is needed to accommodate the 200 attendees. The Doubletree further stated that the refreshments were non-negotiable and non-severable from the Day Meeting Package fee. They have up to twelve separate meetings occurring in conference rooms throughout the EMC, and the continuous break station (available from 7:00 am to 5:00 pm each day) is shared by the NRC and other conferences at the hotel.

The price is determined fair and reasonable by comparing the quoted price to prices previously paid by the NRC for other meeting package pricing with non-severable food services. This approach is consistent with price analysis techniques for acquisitions below the Simplified Acquisition Threshold under FAR Part 13. Specifically, the package cannot be meaningfully compared to facilities that could potentially provide severable pricing, because it is conjectural that they exist, since no such concerns responded to this solicitation

For the FY10 IRRS Mission Meeting in October 2010, under purchase order NRC-DR-10-0162, NRC paid a package price of \$109 per person per day for 23 attendees. For the Regulatory Information Conference (RIC) in March 2010, under contract NRC-03-10-094, NRC paid a price of \$74 per person per day for 1,200 attendees.

#### **Breakout Room Price Reasonableness Determination**

The Doubletree breakout room was quoted at a price of \$125 per day, for a total of \$312.50. The price is determined fair and reasonable by comparing the quoted price to prices paid by the NRC for similar services in the past. For the EDO Senior Management Retreat in September 2011, under competitively-awarded purchase order NRC-HQ-11-P-23-0147, NRC paid a price of \$125 per day, plus a 22% service charge, for a total of \$152.50 per day.

#### Additional Audiovisual Equipment Price Reasonableness Determination

Additional channel mixer and microphones were quoted at a combined price of \$2,141.10. No Doubletree commercial list price is available for the audiovisual equipment. The price is determined fair and reasonable by comparing the quoted price to the Marriott's commercial list price (Attachment #2), as shown below:
