ADM

The various bills being introduced in Congress to limit agency spending on conferences as currently proposed, require agency-level approvals at funding levels below what NRC spends on RIC. The 2012 RIC cost NRC \$730K (\$300K for the hotel space & \$430K for registration & event support). I have asked OCA to keep ADM informed as any of the legislation appears to gain significant bipartisan support.

As a follow up to today's update of the Chairman's goals, staff is meeting with LCOR/Turner from 8:00 a.m. to Noon to review in detail the proposed schedule leading up to the Nov 30 completion of 3WFN. More to come next week on results of our joint review.

The SSG approved 2 remaining procurements to implement the acquisition system today.

CSO

Waiting on final results of the Blue Team testing, expected in about 2 weeks from NSA. No schedule yet for Red Team testing.

The quarterly PHISHMe test should begin May 1.
