There was a news report stating that areas around nuclear plants have become far more crowded and difficult to evacuate.

08/30/11 **NRC: Update evacuation plans near nuclear plants** By Matthew Daly - Associated Press

**Nuclear power plants must provide updated estimates of how long it would take to evacuate nearby communities in an emergency under a new rule approved by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission.**

- **AS SOON AS POSSIBLE, PLEASE PROVIDE US WITH EXELON'S ESTIMATES UNDER THE NEW RULE APPROVED BY NRC, OF HOW LONG IT WOULD TAKE TO EVACUATE COMMUNITIES NEARBY LIMERICK NUCLEAR PLANT IN AN EMERGENCY.**

By law, evacuations must be prepared for 10 miles around every nuclear plant, but plans haven't kept up with changing populations.

There do not appear to be updated plans for Limerick's 10 mile zone to include new 2010 census data.

- If there are no updated plans, why not?
- If there are updated plans to include 2010 census data, please e-mail new plans as soon as possible.
