
Shirley Danner Rodriguez has been appointed Pharmacy Radiation Safety Officer and is responsible for ensuring the safe use of radioactive materials. The Pharmacy Radiation Safety Officer is responsible for managing the radiation safety program; identifying radiation safety problems; initiating, recommending, or providing corrective actions; verifying implementation of corrective actions; and ensuring compliance with regulations. The Pharmacy Radiation Safety Officer is hereby delegated the authority necessary to meet those responsibilities. This specifically includes having sufficient authority, organizational freedom, and management prerogative to:


1. Have unhampered access to all activities at his or her facility involving radioactive materials to identify radiation safety problems;
2. Immediately stop, without coordination with management, any activity at his or her facility involving the use of licensed materials by any user that might result in an unsafe situation or a violation of NRC or Agreement State requirements;
3. Initiate, recommend, or implement appropriate corrective actions; and
4. Verify the implementation of actions taken to correct radiation safety problems.

The Pharmacy Radiation Safety Officer is also responsible for assisting the Corporate Radiation Safety Committee and Corporate Radiation Safety Officer in the performance of their duties.

All of us have a critical responsibility in ensuring the safe use of radioactive materials. I ask that you lend your full support to this important function.
