Dear Mr. Lambert:

This letter refers to your letter dated October 16, 2012, responding to our letter and Notice of Violation (Notice) dated August 16, 2012.

The Notice described two violations which had been identified by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) during an inspection and previous email communications with the Office of International Programs on and subsequent to January 30, 2012, and April 12, 2012.

Thank you for describing your corrective and preventive actions with regard to Violation A. These actions will be reviewed during a future inspection of your licensed program.

With regard to Violation B, Transport Logistics International, Inc. contested the violation and described the basis for the dispute. The NRC is currently reviewing the basis for your dispute and we will notify you of the results of this review in writing when our review is completed. We expect to complete our review within 60 days.
