INFORMATION FROM WESTINGHOUSE ON JULY 30, 2012, REVISION TO
THE HEMATITE PHYSICAL SECURITY PLAN

Dear Mr. Copp:

By your letter dated July 31, 2012, you submitted a request for approval of the July 30, 2012, Revision to the Westinghouse Hematite Physical Security Plan (ADAMS Accession No. ML12214A475). The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff has reviewed this latest Plan. As a result of that review, the staff has identified areas where additional information is required in order to complete its review. Enclosed are requests for additional information (RAIs).

The sensitive nature of these RAIs requires special handling. The RAIs are Official Use Only (OUO) documents. They can be transmitted by fax or e-mail in accordance with the transmission requirements noted below and can be discussed by phone. However, the responses to the RAIs will most likely be Safeguards Information (SGI) and should be handled in accordance with SGI handling requirements:
