Dear Sir or Madam,

PIKA International hereby notifies the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission that we will be initiating activities under our license at a temporary job site as outlined below. Note that although this is a waste survey and packaging project, normally not requiring notification, a project work plan was prepared per the client's instruction. Therefore, this is a project with a "site specific work package" (reference license condition 15).


PIKA's NRC licensed activities at the site will be under the management of Mrs. Kathleen Anthony (916-920-9463), kanthony@pikainc.com), as Project Manager. All site activities will be conducted in accordance with license requirements and implemented through project work plans, accident prevention plan, and procedural compliance. Activities performed at the site will be under the oversight of Ms. Dorothy Richards, client's point of contact (telephone 256-895-1419).

- A. Estimated type, quantity and physical form of licensed material to be used: the waste to be handled is contaminated with depleted uranium. Total activity has not been measured but is estimated to be less than 1 kg of uranium.
- B. The specific site location is Schofield Army Barracks (BAX), Oahu, Hawaii 96857.
- C. The purpose of this project is to survey debris removed from the BAX firing range and identify uranium (DU) contamination. All DU-contaminated items are to be segregated, packaged and turned over to the installation for proper disposal. A work plan has been prepared, "Material Potentially Presenting an Explosive Hazard Handling and Disposal at Schofield Barracks and Hawaii Active Installation Support, All Islands, Hawaii," October 24, 2012.

- D. The estimated start date for these activities is November 15, 2012. The estimated completion date is December 20, 2012.

License condition 14 addresses the situation where multiple licenses exist at a job site. However, at this site, there will be only one license in force. Licensed material is, and will remain under NRC License number 06-30556-01 issued to Cabrera Services, Inc. (exp. 9/30/20). A license interface agreement with Cabrera is attached.

Subject: Licensing Interface: Depleted Uranium at Schofield Barracks, Oahu, HI

The purpose of this memo is to define the interface between two NRC licenses in effect at Schofield Barracks (BAX) between Nov. 15, 2012 and about December 31, 2012. PIKA will be surveying and containerizing range debris, possibly contaminated with depleted uranium (DU).

The DU already known to be present at BAX is currently under the license of Cabrera Services, Inc. (NRC License number 06-30556-01). Any DU discovered by PIKA will be turned over to the Cabrera representative and will be placed under their license.

Procedures, rules and regulations related to controlled areas, PPE, etc. will be determined by Cabrera, and followed by PIKA. This will require completion of Cabrera's radworker training and accompanying challenge test (up to 4 hours). PIKA is allowed to conduct surveys for release of material from the controlled area (RCA), and will use Cabrera procedures and release limits. No further evaluation of containerized waste will be provided by Cabrera for the contents of these containers. However, PIKA personnel and any vehicles used to transport containerized waste will be released out of the RCA by Cabrera personnel.

PIKA's radiological survey results in controlled areas, including container release surveys, will be provided to Cabrera, for their records.

Emergency actions, if required, will also be determined and managed by Cabrera, which PIKA will follow.

This memo represents a licensing interface agreement between PIKA and Cabrera. Future modifications, if any, will be likewise documented.
