SUBJECT: DISCUSSION REGARDING LAKE CITY ARMY AMMUNITION PLANT
(LCAAP) AREA 10 CONCERNING RELEASE FOR UNRESTRICTED
USE (CONTROL NO. 576093) AND FINANCIAL ASSURANCE.

On the above date, the NRC and representatives from Lake City Army Ammunition Plant (LCAAP) discussed current license amendment requesting the release of LCAAP Area 10 for unrestricted use from their NRC license and the financial assurance associated with the site.

Regarding the amendment request to remove LCAAP Area 10 from the license, the NRC stated that it has reviewed the final status survey report and does not have any additional questions regarding the report at this time. The NRC is continuing process the amendment request and will contact the licensee at a future date if additional information is required.

Regarding the financial assurance, the NRC requested that the licensee submit an updated Decommissioning Funding Plan (DFP) which includes LCAAP Area 10. Specifically, the licensee shall submit a revised Statement of Intent which includes Area 10. In accordance with NRC regulations (Federal Register Volume 76, No. 117), the NRC informed the licensee representatives that such a submittal shall be received no later than December 17, 2012.
