AUTHORIZING: The average daily withdrawal and use of 0.0777 million gallons per day or a maximum daily withdrawal and use of 0.4248 million gallons per day for a total annual allocation not to exceed 28.3605 million gallons per calendar year.

LOCATED IN Taylor COUNTY, TWP 07 South RGE 07 East SEC 23

This Permit is issued pursuant to Application 2-83-00183 dated 5/4/1989 for the Use of Water as specified above and subject to the Conditions as set forth below. Said Application, including all plans and specifications attached thereto, is by reference made a part hereof.

Upon written notice to the permittee, this permit may be temporarily modified, or restricted under a Declaration of Water Shortage or a Declaration of Emergency due to Water Shortage in accordance with provisions of Ch. 373, Fla. Statutes, 1973 and applicable rules and regulations of the Suwannee River Water Management District.

This Permit may be permanently or temporarily revoked, in whole or in part, for the violation of the conditions of the permit or for the violation of any provision of the Water Resources Act and regulations thereunder.

This Permit does not convey to permittee any property rights or privileges other than those specified herein, nor relieve the permittee from complying with any law, regulation, or requirement affecting the rights of other bodies or agencies.

**CONDITIONS ARE AS FOLLOWS:**

- Nothing in this permit should be construed to limit the authority of the Suwannee River Water Management District to declare a water shortage and issue orders pursuant to Section 373.175, Florida Statutes, or to formulate a rule for implementation during times of water shortage pursuant to Section 373.246, Florida Statutes. In the event of water shortage as declared by the Board, the permittee shall adhere to any limitations on withdrawal or use ordered by the District.
- This permit is classified as Unconfined Floridan Aquifer for privately owned community public water system.
- Permittee shall allow District personnel at reasonable times and at District expense or with District equipment to monitor withdrawal rates and volumes authorized by this permit.
- The permittee shall allow District personnel reasonable access for the purpose of collecting water quality samples from any permitted withdrawal site.
- The permittee shall allow District personnel reasonable access for the purpose of measuring water levels in any well for which a withdrawal is authorized as part of this permit.
- Permittee shall mail to the District a copy of the "Drinking Water Treatment Plant Daily Operating Summary" (DER form 17-1.208(S)) not later than 9 working days after the end of each month. The water use permit number shall be displayed on all reports.
