On October 23, 2012, I forwarded a draft copy of the Environmental Assessment (EA) and Finding of No Significant Impact for approval of the Decommissioning Plan for the United States Department of Agriculture's (USDA) Low-Level Radioactive Burial Site (LLRBS) at their Beltsville Agricultural Research Center (BARC) in Beltsville, MD. The Decommissioning Plan will eventually be incorporated into an amendment of the USDA's NRC license. Based on your initial review, you had a question regarding "exclusive federal jurisdiction" of the Beltsville Agricultural Research Center. I contacted the USDA's RSO who provided the attached response confirming that the USDA Beltsville Agricultural Research Center is an area of exclusive jurisdiction. As we discussed today, please send me an E-mail confirming your review so that I can document the Maryland Department of the Environment's comments and I can proceed with approval from our Office of the General Counsel and get the EA published in the Federal Register.

As we also discussed, I will let you know when we finally approve the Decommissioning Plan and when we intend to perform site inspections. The USDA expects the project to go well into 2013.

The NRC has asked me whether ARS can confirm that BARC (specifically the LLRBS) is an area of Exclusive Federal Jurisdiction. This is to determine whether the State of MD Radiological Health Program has any jurisdiction over the contractors we use to clean-up this site.

The NRC defines an area of exclusive Federal jurisdiction as an area over which the Federal government exercises legal control without interference from the jurisdiction and administration of State law. The creation of an area of exclusive Federal jurisdiction occurs as a result of State consent at the time the Federal government acquires control over the land.


Sorry to bother you about this but this is one of those procedural issues they would like to clarify and the State of MD has asked them about it. Please let me know if you have any questions.

Good afternoon John,

That is my interpretation based on information provided of the LLRB location. Also, conveyed in subject documents some rights-of ways show in Deed L 401 P100. PEPCO does have an exception of the Transmission Line right-of-way in this document but shown in the attached deed conveys 31 parcels in fee simple and four easements/right-of-ways from Rowland and Lygia Bortner to PEPCO on the opposite side away from the LLRB location. Based on drawings PEPCO's ownership on that side does not interfere with the LLRB location provided.
