ORDER

(Scheduling Conference Call)

On Monday, December 3, 2012 at 2:00 PM Eastern Standard Time, this Board will hold a conference call regarding scheduling and management in this proceeding in light of a March 27, 2012 NRC Confirmatory Action Letter (CAL) issued to Southern California Edison Company (SCE), and the Commission's November 8, 2012 decision in CLI-12-20 referring to the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board Panel that portion of Friends of the Earth's June 18, 2012 intervention petition challenging the CAL. In particular, the Commission directs (CLI-12-20, slip op. at 5) that a duly constituted Board "consider whether: (1) the [CAL] issued to SCE constitutes a *de facto* license amendment that would be subject to a hearing opportunity under Section 189a [of the Atomic Energy Act]; and, if so, (2) whether the petition meets the standing and contention admissibility requirements of 10 C.F.R. § 2.309."

The call is expected to last no more than sixty (60) minutes. At or before noon on Friday, November 30, 2012, participants¹ should e-mail the Licensing Board's law clerk, Onika

Williams, at Onika.Williams@nrc.gov, to obtain the telephone number and pass code for the December 3 teleconference. The Board asks that all participants call into the teleconference a few minutes before the conference is scheduled to begin so that it commences promptly. Only the designated representatives of the parties may participate in the conference call.

In the event that a participant desires to have the conference monitored by a person or persons at a different location, upon request, Ms. Williams will make a reasonable number of additional telephone lines available for that purpose.² The conference will be transcribed, and the transcript will promptly be placed in the NRC's electronic docket, where it may be freely accessed by the public.
