SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF THE NOVEMBER 26, 2012, PUBLIC WEBINAR
ON INTERIM STAFF GUIDANCE: SCREENING,
PRIORITIZATION AND IMPLEMENTATION DETAILS FOR
JAPAN LESSONS LEARNED NEAR-TERM TASK FORCE
RECOMMENDATION REGARDING SEISMIC REEVALUATION

On November 26, 2012, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC or the staff) held a Category 2 public webinar¹ to continue development of the guidance document supporting Recommendation 2.1, seismic reevaluations. This recommendation can be found in *Near-Term Task Force [NTTF] Recommendations for Enhancing Reactor Safety in the 21st Century* report, issued July 12, 2011.² The seismic reevaluations were identified as a Tier 1 recommendation, which are under consideration for implementation without unnecessary delay. Consequently, on March 12, 2012, the NRC issued a request for information per Title 10 to the *Code of Federal Regulations*, Section 50.54(f). Enclosure 1 to the request for information letter includes Recommendation 2.1: Seismic.

The meeting participants are included in the enclosure to this document.

The meeting participants used a webinar format to review and edit the draft guidance document, "Screening Prioritization and Implementation Details (SPID)," authored by the Electric Power Research Institute (EPRI) staff, with input from the NRC staff. The focus of the discussions was on final EPRI staff adjustments to Section 7, “Spent Fuel Pool Integrity Evaluations,” and Appendix B, “Development of Site-Specific Amplification Factors,” based on NRC staff comments from the November 20, 2012, public webinar.

At the conclusion of the meeting, the staff stated that all NRC comments had been addressed except for one comment on Appendix B. Nuclear Energy Institute staff stated that they would make a final adjustment to Appendix B based on the NRC staff comment, and submit the final revision on November 27, 2012, with a letter requesting endorsement.

Members of the public participated in the webinar and asked clarifying questions throughout the meeting.
