Dear Commissioners::

I request an extension of time for the hearings, as well as an extension of time for the entire environmental scoping process, as the NRC has not provided the public with enough time to study the issues and prepare either written or oral comments. There was a lack of adequate information in the Federal Register Notice, which the NRC should have provided in the first instance -- such as what the proposed action is, and what are reasonable alternatives to it, basic components of any National Environmental Impact Statement (NEPA) environmental impact statement process. Please withdraw the scoping notice and re-publish it in a form that passes legal muster under NEPA. In addition, I urge you to hold regional hearings, so that those living in the shadows of nuclear power plants and their stored high-level radioactive waste LIKE ME can attend and talk to NRC officials in person.
