On October 3, 2012, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission received the electronic submission of AUC LLC combined source and 11e.(2) byproduct materials license application requesting authorization to construct and operate its proposed Reno Creek ISR project to be located in the Powder River Basin near Wright, Wyoming. This email acknowledges receipt of the application and presents a general review schedule.

The electronic application has been placed into the agency's Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) under Accession No. ML122890785. However, staff will not commence its formal acceptance review of the application until March 2013. The staff expects to complete the acceptance review within 60 to 90 days or by June 2013. At the time the application is accepted, the staff will undertake a detailed technical review. This technical review may result in requests for additional information (RAIs), which will be issued by January 2014. The remaining schedule will be determined after any RAI responses are received and accepted.
