On March 12, 2012, the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff issued a 10 CFR 50.54(f) letter to Wolf Creek Nuclear Operating Corporation (WCNOG) (Reference 1). Enclosure 4 of Reference 1 contains specific Requested Actions, Requested Information, and Required Responses associated with Near-Term Task Force (NTTF) Recommendation 2.3 (Flooding). This letter provides WCNOG's 180-day response to Reference 1 regarding flooding walkdowns for Wolf Creek Generating Station (WCGS).



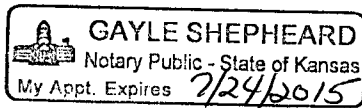
