PPL Bell Bend, LLC is submitting, per Agency request, a Plan Approval application in coordination with the submittal of the Joint Permit Application for the proposed PPL Bell Bend Nuclear Power Plant (BBNPP) to be located in Salem Township, Luzerne County, Pennsylvania.

The plant is proposed to be built on property adjacent to the existing Susquehanna Steam Electric Station (SSES), a two unit nuclear power plant that is an existing permitted facility under State-Only Permit Number 40-00027, a synthetic minor operating permit.

In the Agency response to the BBNPP Request for Determination, it was stated that the BBNPP Plan Approval should be included with the pending SSES Plan Approval 40-399-071 based on the belief that the SSES and BBNPP have the same owner and occupy the same property. PPL does not concur with this analysis. Similar to the situation involving the Lower Mount Bethel Energy plant and the Martins Creek SES, BBNPP will be a separate merchant plant with its own tax ID and plant-owned property. Like the other plant owners, PPL Bell Bend, LLC will be a subsidiary of PPL Corp. Supporting documentation for the conclusion that BBNPP is a separate facility is being submitted as Appendix F of this application.

In accordance with the Plan Approval application instructions, three (3) copies of the application are being provided along with a check for the application fee of \$1700.
