The Bonneville Power Administration (BPA) entered into a contract in 1970 with the Eugene Water and Electric Board (EWEB) regarding EWEB's thirty percent ownership share of the Trojan Nuclear Power Plant (Trojan). Under this contract, BPA provides the funding for EWEB's share of Trojan costs and in turn received EWEB's share of Trojan's power. This contract remains in place until its termination at the end of all decommissioning activities. Under this contract, BPA has a commitment to pay any decommissioning costs attributable to EWEB for both the Trojan Nuclear Plant and the Independent Spent Fuel Storage Installation. The Trojan costs are included in BPA's costs which are required by law to be recovered by BPA from its ratepayers.
