SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF THE PUBLIC MEETING TO DISCUSS ENVIRONMENTAL REQUESTS FOR ADDITIONAL INFORMATION DRAFT RESPONSES RELATING TO THE ALTERNATIVE SITE SELECTION PROCESS FOR FLORIDA POWER AND LIGHT'S TURKEY POINT UNITS 6 AND 7 COMBINED LICENSE APPLICATION

On Friday, December 7, 2012, members of the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) along with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers-Miami Field Office (USACE) held a Category 1 public meeting with representatives of Florida Power and Light (FPL) at the Marriott Miami Dadeland Hotel in Miami, Florida, regarding the environmental review for Turkey Point Units 6 and 7 combined license (COL). The purpose of the meeting was to discuss and clarify, as appropriate, the requests for additional information (RAI) draft responses the NRC received from FPL relating to the alternative site selection process. RAIs 6353, 6879 and the draft responses discussed can be accessed in the NRC's Agency-wide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) under accession number (ML13002A496).

The meeting began with introductions from the NRC and USACE staff as well as representatives from FPL. Next, the NRC staff gave a presentation outlining the environmental review activities accomplished to date, upcoming review activities, and the specific alternative site selection issues to be discussed.

At the end of the meeting, 1) a number of RAI draft responses were determined to be adequate; 2) the NRC and USACE agreed to reevaluate several RAI draft responses based on clarifying information FPL provided during the meeting; 3) FPL agreed to supplement several of the draft responses with additional information for NRC and USACE consideration; 4) and all participants agreed a follow up public teleconference in the near future would be scheduled to close out unresolved RAIs.

Before the meeting was adjourned, members of the public were invited to ask questions and provide comments. Approximately 50 people attended the meeting. Attendees included members of the public and local media, representatives of the NRC and its contractor, Pacific Northwest National Laboratory, representatives from the USACE, National Park Service, FPL and its contractors, and State and local government officials.
