Dear Mr. Fry:

We have received a request to terminate NRC License Number 24-32024-01 on September 13, 2012. On Form 314 dated September 13, 2012, you stated that you transferred all licensed materials to Superior Bowen Asphalt Company, LLC (NRC License Number 24-26162-01) on September 13, 2012; however, Superior Bowen Asphalt Company, LLC had not received your license materials as we confirmed with Jennifer Breuer, the Radiation Safety Officer for Superior Bowen Asphalt Company, LLC, by telephone on September 19, 2012.

On September 19, September 28, and October 16, 2012, we contacted Mr. Lamas but no response has been received.

We sent a letter to Mr. Lamas and requested additional information regarding the transferring of the licensee's portable gauges be provided to us by October 31, 2012. As of today, we have not received any responses from Mr. Lamas.

In order to terminate your license, please provide the following information.

- 1) Form 314 with correct information.
- 2) A copy of the receipt confirming that Superior Bowen Asphalt Company (NRC License No. 24-26162-01) has received all of your licensed materials.
- 2) Please confirm that there have been no leaking sources identified at your facilities.


Please note that without the above information, your license could not be terminated and you are still liable for the license fee.

Title 10 Code of Federal Regulations (10 CFR) Part 30.9, in part, requires information provided to the Commission by a licensee shall be complete and accurate in all material respect. In addition, Part 30.10, in part, requires the licensee or its employees may not deliberately submit information that the person submitting the information knows to be incomplete or inaccurate in some respect material to the NRC and a person who violates this may be subject to enforcement action in accordance with the procedures in 10 CFR Part 2, Subpart B.

To continue the review of your request, we request that you submit your response to this letter by November 30, 2012. Your response must be dated and signed by authorized personnel and referred to Control Number 579113.
