**Subject:** Notification of Completion of Commitments Required Prior to Entry into the Period of Extended Operation

**Reference:** NUREG 1796, "Safety Evaluation Report Related to the License Renewal of the Dresden Nuclear Power Station, Units 2 and 3 and Quad Cities Nuclear Power Station, Units 1 and 2"

The referenced safety evaluation report identifies regulatory commitments which are required to be completed before Quad Cities enters the Period of Extended Operation (December 14, 2012). The Renewed Facility Operating Licenses for Unit 1 and Unit 2 include a license condition stating that Exelon Generation Company, LLC, shall notify the NRC in writing when implementation of these activities is completed. The purpose of this letter is to notify the NRC that Exelon has completed activities required for entry into the Period of Extended Operation.
