**Proposals for Radioactive Waste Management**

I do not have a code referenece for this action, as none has been assigned. A directive has been issued that rules should be prepared for management of radioactive waste of all kinds.

I ask that four key points be considered when making decisions as to the future of radioactive waste and drafting an environmental impact statement.

- 1., First and foremost, there should be an end to generation of radioactive waste.  
[This would assume no new nuclear power plants, no production of nuclear weapons etc.]
2. It should include an assessment of overfilling of highly radioactive irradiated nuclear fuel pools.
3. It should compare and contrast possible scenarios from disruption of current dry storage, fuel pools and "hardened" dry storage.
4. It should exclude off-site interim consideration of waste storage because of unsolvable problems in transporting nuclear waste from one site to another.  
Presently there is no safe way to transport nuclear waste.

In considering these points, please bear in mind the necessity to cease production of nuclear waste.
