SUBJECT: REVIEW OF FORMER ETHYL CORPORATION LICENSE NO. 21-00641-01

Dear Mr. Denton:

This letter is in regard to the property located at 1600 West Eight Mile Road, Ferndale, Michigan which is the location where the Ethyl Corporation conducted activities licensed by the U.S. Atomic Energy Commission (AEC) under License No. 21-00641-01 from 1954 to 1957. The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) has undertaken a review of more than 31,000 previously terminated radioactive materials licenses throughout the United States. The purpose of the review is to confirm that there is documentation to show that licenses terminated before 1985 were terminated in accordance with current NRC guidelines. The review has identified more than 600 licenses for which there was insufficient documentation in NRC's achieved files.

The property identified above was listed on such a license. The NRC has been unable to find some clearly documented bases to support the license termination. From discussions with you, we understand that you also have no documentation to support the license termination. Therefore, a site survey will need to be made. We would appreciate your cooperation in allowing us to access your property to perform this survey.
