Dear Mr. Mitchell:

This is to confirm our recent telephone conversation concerning a misunderstanding in your February 2, 1979 letter to Congressman Young regarding the movement of contaminated soil from a site on Latty Avenue in Hazelwood, Missouri to a site adjacent to the St. Louis International Airport.

Apparently, you misunderstood me during our earlier conversation which you cited in Item 2 of your letter to Congressman Young. The site I referred to, where there was avoidance of radiological contamination in a storm drainage ditch from surface erosion, was the airport site. This contamination in the drainage ditch between Brown Road and the airport site has been documented in the radiological survey of this site which was performed by the Oak Ridge National Laboratory for the Department of Energy (DOE). Conversations with responsible DOE officials indicate that this ditch will be decontaminated and replaced with an underground storm drain tile to prevent future erosion at the airport site.

Thank you for sending me a copy of the letter to Congressman Young, and if any questions should arise concerning either of these sites, please feel free to call.
