Dear Mr. Berger:

As per our meeting with Drs. Gerry LaRoche and Ed Shum (NRC Representatives) on April 3 and the terms of the April 17, 1986 letter of Dr. LaRoche to us, we will revise the draft report on, "Engineering Evaluation of Option for Dispostion of Radioactively Contaminated Residues Presently in the West Lake Landfill, St. Louis, MO."

The revised report will include the suggested alternatives and modifications made by NRC representatives. The scope of the report will change from permanent dispostion of the radioactively contaminated residues in West Lake Landfill to more temporary storage. Option B in the report will be modified to include a situation where the adjacent farm land cannot be acquired and the wastes in that boundary area will be excavated and buried in a secure place in the existing landfill. The Option C will be discarded since at the present time there is no waste repository in the country that will accept radioactive wastes contaminated with hazardous wastes.

Dr. Shum will rewrite the radiological assessments that were covered in Chapters 3 and 4 and Appendix D of the report. He will include the new water quality analysis results at the landifll site which are being completed by your group.

We will provide a marked copy of the draft report to you for retyping by NRC as suggested by Dr. LaRoche. We expect to finish our portion of work by June 16, 1986. We are enclosing a budget for our portion of work that will be needed to complete the work.
