Dear USNRC Representative:

This is a request to change the tie-down conditions regarding our Radiation Policy Committee (RPC) as detailed in the Pfizer-Groton Labs license renewal application of July 1, 2004 (pp. 4-5). The change is prompted by the contraction of the site radiation safety program resulting in representation by relevant departments totaling less than the 9 members stipulated in the application.

Therefore, we would like to request that the tie-down be changed to indicate “representation by departments using radioactive materials” rather than the “9-member representation” currently stated. Further, we would like to change the definition of a quorum from “a minimum of five (5) members” to 50% of the current total membership of the RPC to allow future flexibility.

No other change to the wording in the application regarding the RPC is needed at this time.
