Sandia is the lead lab for the DOE-RW Yucca Mountain License Application. While this license application does include a transportation component, Sandia is not responsible for that aspect of the application. The transportation work that we have for DOE-RW is focused on maintaining the RADTRAN Transportation Risk Analysis code, which will be used as part of this project, and the determination of the response spent fuel to HEDD attacks. HEDD attacks are outside the scope of the work being performed for the NRC under this contract.

In addition, Sandia has in the past and likely will in the future, performed package testing for various vendors. These vendors have used the information obtained from those tests to support their Safety Analysis Report for Packagings that were submitted to the NRC for certification. However, the risk assessment in this contract is focused on analytically determining the response of spent fuel casks to accident conditions that are extra-regulatory, and none of the work in the past nor any of the foreseeable future work is associated with extra-regulatory conditions.
